

Prof. Dr. Neki Frasheri

Neki Frasheri is graduated at the Department of Mathematics of the Faculty of Natural Sciences, University of Tirana in 1971-1976. Completed his doctorate thesis for "Mathematical aspects and algorithms of finite elements in plate bending" in University of Tirana in 1984-85. Received the title "Old Scientific Collaborator (Docent)" from the Scientific Council of the Institute of Informatics and Applied Mathematics in 1991, and the title "Research Leader (Professor)" from High Council of Attestation in 1994. In 2008 he received the title Academician.

Specialized as system engineer for operating systems and computer networks at Training Centers of BULL HN, Paris France, during 1984-85 and in 1988. Worked as lecturer on applied mathematics (finite elements) and informatics (theory of languages and compilation) in Chairs of Mathematics and of Informatics of University of Tirana in 1981-1996. At the same time worked as system and network engineer at Institute of Informatics and Applied Mathematics (INIMA) in 1985-1993; and as vice-director and head of Software department of INIMA in 1993-2007.

From 2008-2016 worked as Head of Center for Research and Development in IT at Faculty of Information Technology of Polytechnic University of Tirana, and lecturer in distributed systems. From 2016 professor at Faculty of Information Technology. He is also lecturer on operating systems in the Section of Applied Informatics at Faculty of Economy of University of Tirana, and Mediterranean University of Albania.

Participated in a number of international workshops on Internet technologies organized by ISOC and CEENet, and was involved for many years as technical responsible for Internet domain names under ccTld AL. From 1994 he was technical leader for local teams involved in several European projects of Framework Programmes, including regional EC projects ETCETERA, HANNIBAL, ISOTEIA, SEEREN, SEEREN2, SEE-GRID, SEE-GRID2, SEE-GRID-SCI, SEERA-EI, ICT-WEB-PROMS, HP-SEE, VI-SEEM.
