## **CALL FOR ADMISSION TO THE PHD PROGRAMS AT THE POLITECNICO DI TORINO (01.01.2014 / 31.12.2016)**

Public competitive examinations are announced for admission to the **three-year Research Doctorate** Programs of the **Politecnico di Torino** for the term 01/01/2014 – 31/12/2016. The competitive examinations will award a total of 340 positions and 139 scholarships, distributed as in the announcement available online at: [http://dottorato.polito.it/bandi\\_en.html](http://dottorato.polito.it/bandi_en.html).

The Politecnico di Torino offers positions in four areas:

- **CIVIL ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURE** (70 PLACES; 24 SCHOLARSHIPS)
- **ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONICS, INFORMATION AND COMMUNICATIONS ENGINEERING** (108 PLACES; 46 SCHOLARSHIPS)
- **INDUSTRIAL ENGINEERING** (112 PLACES; 43 SCHOLARSHIPS)
- **PHYSICAL, CHEMICAL AND MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES FOR ENGINEERING** (50 PLACES; 26 SCHOLARSHIPS)

The ability of the applicants will be judged by the comparative assessment of the educational and scientific curriculum; the Examination Boards will evaluate the candidates both through a **compulsory interview**, which could be face to face or remote, and **through all documents/qualifications submitted for the online application**. Each candidate will be evaluated on the basis of **the titles presented**, as specified in art. 2 of the announcement.

### **REQUIREMENTS** to apply:

- ✓ **Master of Science** degree by 31 December 2013  
Will be able to apply:
  - Candidates who obtained a **Master of Science** Degree in Italy with a minimum mark of 95/110;
  - Candidates who obtained any other equivalent academic qualification abroad with the minimum average grade expressed in Appendix 2 of the call for admission;
  - Candidates who will obtain their Master Degree by and no later than December 31, 2013, with minimum average grade 25/30 and the final mark higher than said threshold (This will be checked at time of enrolment).
- ✓ **a certificate establishing the proficiency in English language** (IELTS, TOEFL, Cambridge ESOL with the minimum score specified in art.2, letter b of the announcement)

In addition, **specific positions have been reserved to recipients of a scholarship to attend a PhD program** provided by governmental, national or international public bodies who, at the end of the selection, are eligible for admission to a PhD (see art. 5 of the announcement)
